The **3 METHOD CORRECTIONS** are dynamic flows for which we rarely have much time in the 5-Day Seminar.

They harmonize the relationships *within* Trinity Energy, relationships of **Main Central (FIRE)**, **Supervisor (AIR)** and **Mediator (WATER)**. They also harmonize relationships of Trinity Energy (Text 1) *with* 12 Organ Function Energy (Text 2).

They are deep cleaners, opening up the Body (**EARTH**) to **SOURCE**. Because of their broad reach they are especially useful for chronic conditions, critical projects and deep emotional stress. Mary says of these flows, "One application can change a lifetime of disharmony".

Each day of this **HANDS-ON RETREAT** will be devoted to one of the 3 Methods. You'll receive each flow bilaterally twice and practice applying it four times - in all, we share 18 hands-on sessions during this 3-day Special Topic Class. The hands-on will be preceded and followed by lecture/study group sessions (six in all). For those who aren't used to jumper-cabing several hours per day, the retreat is an opportunity to have guidance in developing one's comfort while practicing the Art of Jin Shin Jyutsu.

IMMACULATE HEART RETREAT CENTER is nestled in the piñon-covered foothills of the Rocky Mountains, with the great peaks of the Sangre de Cristos as a backdrop, rising to over 12,000 feet. Quiet and secluded, it's walking distance from Canyon Road, Museum Hill and the Plaza. Conference and dining rooms overlook the Monte Sol and Atalaya mountains, with the Ortiz and Sandia mountain ranges in the distance. At 7,000 feet elevation, Santa Fe enjoys warm sunny days and cool nights in September. Dormitory, semi-private and private rooms are available at reasonable rates. 

LOCAL STUDENTS: sleeping at the Center is optional. The center charges those who don't a \$5 Day Use Fee per day. Even if you live in town, we recommend sharing some meals with the group, for the great food, great conversation and informal study.





LOCATION: Classes will be held at the IMH Retreat and Conference Center, overlooking the Monte Sol and Atalaya mountains, with the Ortiz and Sandia mountain ranges in the distance. The Center, at 50 Mt. Carmel Road, Santa Fe, NM 87505, is just 2 blocks from Museum Hill, 1 mile from Canyon Road, and 2 miles from historic Santa Fe Plaza. Some of the best hiking and biking trails are located in the Center's immediate surroundings. Santa Fe's many outstanding restaurants, galleries, museums and cultural events are only minutes away. MEALS: Delicious, healthy meals are available in the Center's dining room, with special dietary considerations accommodated upon request. Breakfast: \$6-\$10, Luncheon: \$15. No food may be brought from outside. Water only, please. Snacks provided.

Santa Fe's copious excellent restaurants are dinnertime treats.



LODGING: Rooms at the IMH Center, range from \$55 to \$80 per person for a single person, or \$84 to \$100 for two. There are no elevators: most, but not all, rooms are on the second floor. The Sage Inn <http://santafesageinn.com> is a recommended motel close to the town center. There are many pleasant private accommodations in Santa Fe listed at: www.airbnb.com.

ACCESSING SANTA FE: There is an airport in Santa Fe, but most people fly into Albuquerque (generally less expensive). The Sandia Shuttle provides service from the airport to Santa Fe (60 miles) for \$28 one way or \$48 round trip. Here is a link to the shuttle company website: <http://www.sandiashuttle.com>.

Santa Fe weather is always variable, so it is a good idea to bring layers to wear. Winters can be either mild and dry, or quite cold and snowy. Even in summer, evenings can be cool.

CLASS FEES: \$450. A \$50 deposit (refundable up to 30 days before class) will hold your space. Balance is due at registration.

EARLY BIRD RATE: \$405. Pay in full by July 18, 2014 and receive 10% off class fees.

CEUs may be available for nurses, acupuncturists and massage therapists. (Check with Gail at least two weeks before class).

CLASS HOURS: 9:00-5:00 daily.

CLASS MATERIALS: Bring Texts I and II, colored pens, markers or pencils, and paper.
